

Scholarships for West Virginia Residents

Name	Criteria	PSC Amount
Presidential	Minimum 3.8 high school GPA and 30 ACT or 1340 SAT	\$2400 / year (2 years at PSC and 2 years at WVU*)
Rhododendron	Minimum 3.65 high school GPA and 28 ACT or 1260 SAT	\$1800 / year (2 years at PSC and 2 years at WVU*)
Mountaineer	Minimum 3.5 high school GPA and 26 ACT or 1190 SAT	\$1500 / year (2 years at PSC and 2 years at WVU*)
Vandalia	Minimum 3.25 high school GPA and 24 ACT or 1110 SAT	\$1000 / year (2 years at PSC and 2 years at WVU*)
Shenandoah	Minimum 3.00 high school GPA and 22 ACT or 1030 SAT	\$800 / year (2 years at PSC and 2 years at WVU*)
Potomac	Minimum 3.00 high school GPA and 21 ACT or 990 SAT	\$700 / year 1 year at PSC

**These scholarships are fully integrated with the scholarship program at West Virginia University. If a student decides to change campuses to WVU after leaving Potomac State and meets the academic progress standards for these scholarships, the student will be eligible to continue to receive these scholarships at WVU at the current WVU value. The Potomac Scholarship is not a transferable scholarship.*

- Value of scholarship at WVU will be determined by current value of scholarship at WVU when student changes campuses.
- Effective with the incoming freshman class of 2015, PSC uses "Super Scores" for scholarship awarding, so students should submit all scores from each section of the ACT or SAT if the test(s) is taken more than once. The "Super Score" will be calculated using the highest component/subscore from all test information available to PSC.
- If a student is eligible for more than one scholarship from Potomac State College, the student will be awarded the scholarship with the highest dollar value. To retain scholarships for subsequent years, all scholars are required to maintain specific cumulative grade-point averages and to complete a minimum number of credits per year.

- If you qualify for the West Virginia PROMISE scholarship, in most cases your PSC scholarship will be awarded in addition to PROMISE.
