



Scholarships for Residents of Other States

Name	Criteria	PSC Amount
Blue and Gold Level 1	Minimum 3.25 grade point average and 24 ACT or 1110 SAT	\$2000 / year <i>(metro residents)</i> \$3000 / year <i>(other out-of-state residents)</i> 2 years at PSC*
Blue and Gold Level 2	Minimum 3.0 grade point average and 22 ACT or 1030 SAT	\$1500 / year <i>(metro residents)</i> \$2400 / year <i>(other out-of-state residents)</i> 2 years at PSC*
Catamount Award	Minimum 2.5 grade point average and 20 ACT or 950 SAT	\$800 / year <i>(metro residents)</i> \$1000 / year <i>(other out-of-state residents)</i> 1 year at PSC

**These scholarships are fully integrated with the scholarship program at West Virginia University. If a student decides to change campuses to WVU after leaving Potomac State and meets the academic progress standards for these scholarships, the student will be eligible to continue to receive these scholarships at WVU at the current WVU value. The Catamount Award is not a transferable scholarship.*

- Value of scholarship at WVU will be determined by current value of scholarship at WVU when student changes campuses.
- Metro counties include Allegany and Garrett counties, MD; Frederick County, VA; Bedford, Fayette, and Somerset counties, PA.
- Effective with the incoming freshman class of 2015, PSC uses “Super Scores” for scholarship awarding, so students should submit all scores from each section of the ACT or SAT if the test(s) is taken more than once. The “Super Score” will be calculated using the highest component/subscore from all test information available to PSC.
- If a student is eligible for more than one scholarship from Potomac State College, the student will be awarded the scholarship with the highest dollar value. To retain scholarships for subsequent years, all scholars are required to maintain specific cumulative grade-point averages and to complete a minimum number of credits per year.
